The scope of the platform will be enlarged for further indications, such as cardiovascular diseases as CEC's elevated in the blood in many vascular disorders.

Within the framework of Eco4Life, a German-Polish collaboration for clinical proof-of-concept was established by the PUM, ReadGene, Gilupi and coordinated by BioCon Valley.

SHIP International

Studies of Health in Populations SHIP International of the Community medicine University Greifswald is aimed to build up an international consortium of population-based studies with well harmonized data. In sharp contrast to many other consortia, which pool existing data from different studies after data have been collected, SHIP International offers a platform for international collaborators to standardize examinations from the design of their studies and during data collection.

Cardiometabolic and Renal Risk Assessment

BCV together with its members PDA (Polyclinics for Dialysis and Apheresis) and B.A.P. (BioArtProducts) has established a local interdisciplinary network in the Rostock area with focus on the early identification and treatment of atherosclerotic cardiovascular and renal diseases linked to diabetic and dyslipidemic conditions. The aim of this initiative is to improve translation of screening results into daily care by developing individualized treatment strategies in order to avoid or slow down progression toward cardiovascular events and dialysis dependency. During the first BCV workshop on cardiometabolic risk assessement and management in Rostock this spring a simple and cost-effective screening program (KISS = keep it simple screening) was introduced to experts from the Baltic Sea region. The upcoming workshop will provide a platform for further discussions on the subject and will allow clinical and research groups from the Baltic Sea region to join the recent activities.
